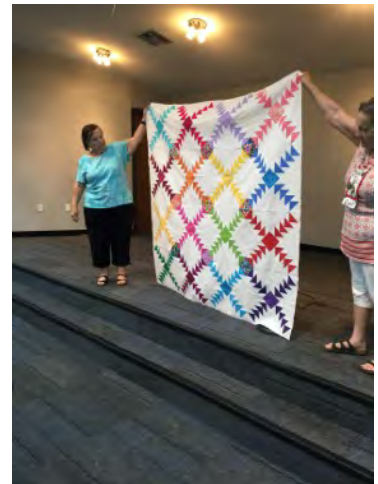

Join us for our first Bi-monthly Block Swap

We would like to start a bimonthly **12' finished block swap** to provide blocks to a block maker and to a community project. How would this work, well on **even** numbered months (June, August, October, December, February, April) a block pattern would be provided and on the **odd** numbered months (July, September, November, January, March, May) two blocks would be brought to the monthly meetings by those members wishing to participate.

One set of blocks would be donated to community projects and the other set would be a prize. All persons who brought blocks would write their name on a slip of paper and the drawn name from that group would win the "prize" and would submit a block to made by the guild in August.

Example: Lisa provides a block pattern for the block swap in **June**. Everyone who would like to make a block brings two to the **July** meeting. Suzy Q wins the drawing for one set of blocks and then she would submit a quilt block pattern in **August** for the next round of block swap.

Blocks submitted will include day and night participants and the lucky winner will be drawn at the **night** meeting.

First Block is the "Box Kite" Block

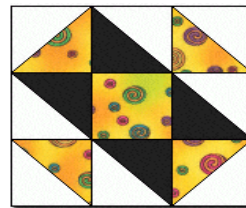

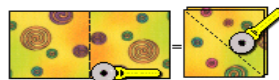

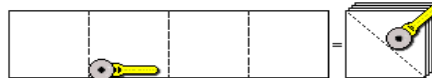
** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



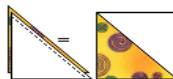
Start by marking and cutting the Color 1 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip into two 4-7/8" squares. Stack these and cut them once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles...



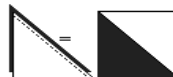
Now mark and cut the Color 2 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip into two 4-7/8" squares. Stack these and cut them once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles...



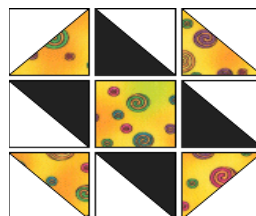
Then mark and cut the Color 3 4-7/8" x 19-1/2" strip into four 4-7/8" squares. Stack these and cut them once on the diagonal to make eight half square triangles...






Using a scant 1/4" seam allowance sew Color 1 and Color 3 triangles right sides together to make four units as shown at top left. Make four more units as shown at bottom left using Color 2 and Color 3 triangles. Trim each of these back to measure 4-1/2" if needed...



Now piece the block by making three horizontal rows, then joining these rows to make the block. Press seams in alternating directions by row.



** Supplies List **

-  Color Color 1 needs: one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip AND one 4-1/2" square
-  Color Color 2 needs: one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip
-  Color Color 3 needs: one 4-7/8" x 19-1/2" strip
