Sorry we missed our September meeting! When will our black cloud move away? Have you all been busy making quilts? Hope you are not all making masks! Well, we do have fun things planned in our future, including our Quilt Show in February. Hope everyone has that date on their calendar - February 12 and 13, 2021. That is when we get to see how you have spent your hibernation! We all need to spend some fun time, so plan on participating in our show.

Carolyn Pic has been distributing Opportunity Quilt tickets. Please sell! This is one of the ways we fundraise. The quilt is so beautiful- the picture alone sells the quilt.

We have made one change this year. We will not have an Opening Night Reception. The reasons are that this is a very busy day setting up and members are tired, as are the vendors. The other consideration is that it costs us money to hold that event. We are not charged for setting up, but because we hold an event in the evening we are charged \$450 room rent. Additionally we have had to pay for refreshments and supplies, last year's cost was approximately \$200. So having that event we have spend approximately \$650. We would rather not have that expense.
