

## St. Andrew Bay Quilters' Guild Guidelines

### "Quilts From the Heart" Quilt Show February 16 and 17, 2018

This annual Quilt Show showcases quilts made by members of the St. Andrew Bay Quilters' Guild. The Quilt Show is a judged competition. Only active members, having paid their yearly dues as of September 1, 2017 and participated in Guild activities, are eligible to participate in the competition. Quilts made by nonmembers may be displayed as space permits.

Quilters may enter one quilt per category. If more than one quilt is entered in a category, only one will be judged. The other will be for display. All quilts entered into the competition must have been completed in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018. THE QUILT SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MOVE A QUILT FROM ONE CATEGORY TO ANOTHER IF THE COMMITTEE FEELS THAT THE NEW CATEGORY IS MORE APPROPRIATE. No tied quilt will be judged. A panel may be allowed as long as it is divided into pieces or sections and is a part of a larger quilt.

The Theme/Challenge category for 2018 is entitled "40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary". The theme celebrates the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Guild's founding. Directions for the theme quilt will be on the Categories page. The show will again have a category called First Time Entry for those members who have never entered a quilt into our show. This quilt will be critiqued by the Judge and will receive a First Entry ribbon.

Each judged category will be eligible for a First, Second, Third place ribbon as well as an Honorable Mention. Additional ribbons are available for Hand Quilting Excellence, Machine Quilting Excellence, Judge's Choice and Best of Show. A individual ribbon, named The Bobbi Award, will be given for excellence in hand work. For the Best of Show winner and Bedsize/First Place Two Person a ribbon will be awarded to the quilt entrant and to the machine quilter (if applicable). A Viewer's Choice award will be presented based on the votes of the show attendees.

All entries must have a 4" sleeve casing attached to the back of the quilt. All large quilts must have a slit or opening in the middle so an extra support hook can be attached. A secured label must be on the back of the quilt listing the quilt maker's name and telephone number. DO NOT USE PAPER LABELS. The label must be loosely covered with a piece of muslin. It can be attached with safety pins, but NO STRAIGHT PINS ARE ALLOWED. Each quilt submitted to the Show Committee must be contained in its own fabric bag (no plastic please) with the quiltmaker's name on bag as well.

Quilts are to be delivered to the Quilt Show Committee on February 13, 2018 at St. Andrew Episcopal Church between 9:00 – 12:00 Noon. Alternate arrangements need to be made to Beverly Pierzchala at (850)271-8913.

Quilts are to be picked up after 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 17, 2018 at the Holley Center, Florida State University/Panama City.

## **QUILT SHOW 2018 CONTEST CATEGORIES**

**1.0 BED SIZE QUILT** A quilt intended to cover a bed. Width 63" or more Length 80" or more  
 Quilt Made by One Person Any technique. May be hand or machine quilted  
 Quilt Made by Two Persons Any technique. May be hand or machine quilted

### **2.0 GROUP QUILT**

Any quilt which three or more people work on the construction or finishing in any way

### **3.0 WALL SIZE QUILT**

#### **3.1 SMALL OR LARGE WALL/ APPLIQUE**

Applique must be the dominant feature of the quilt. The quilt may be hand or machine appliqued. May be hand or machine quilted

**3.2 SMALL WALL / PIECED** Dimensions no larger than 160" total. May be hand or machine quilted.

**3.3 LARGE WALL/PIECED/ONE PERSON** Dimensions larger than 160" The quilt may be hand or machine quilted BUT MUST BE COMPLETED BY ONE PERSON.

#### **3.4 LARGE WALL/PIECED/TWO PERSONS**

Dimensions larger than 160" The quilt may be hand or machine quilted BUT MUST BE COMPLETED BY TWO PERSONS.

### **4.0 THEME / CHALLENGE** 40<sup>th</sup> Year Anniversary

A quilt in this category should be made with red and white material. Any design or pattern may be used. The completed quilt should be no larger than a large wall quilt. It may be hand or machine quilted.

### **5.0 ART/INNOVATIVE**

The quilt should be an original work of art, made for display on a wall; no bedsize allowed. No published pattern may be used. Quilt may be made using any technique with fabrics the primary medium. May be hand or machine quilted. It should contain a finished edge.

### **6.0 MINIATURE**

Any technique may be used (pieced or applique). The category is not determined by size alone; it must be small scale version of a full size quilt. The maximum block size is 4". It should measure less than 24" per side. It must be completed by one person.

### **7.0 FIRST TIME ENTRY**

The quilt entered into this category must be the first quilt the quilt maker entered into our show. The quilt can be any size and made with any technique.

### **8.0 OTHER**

This category includes quilts which do not use three layers of fabric or are not quilted, as in a Grandmother's Flower Garden, Cathedral Window, or Crazy Quilt. Whole cloth quilts are included in this category. Wool work w/o batting may be used. Wool work should be a total wool project, excluding binding and backing. Quilts, as in Summer Quilts, without batting will not be judged.
