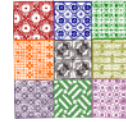
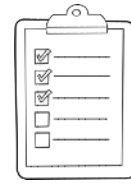

Reminders for Turn In Day

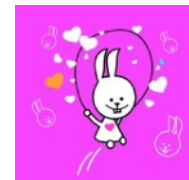


Please remember your quilt needs a hanging sleeve and a label that is covered. Each quilt needs its own cloth bag labeled with your name and the name of your quilt.

Anyone

interested in teaching a 20-30 minutes mini workshop should contact JoEllen Rodgers. SABQG contracted for 2 billboards to advertise our Quilt Show everyday through our show dates. We have 102 quilts entered into the show. The judge is set. Carol Schulz is in heading up Turn-in-Day activity. For those of you who have entered quilts, you need to have your quilt at the church (Grace Presbyterian Church) Tuesday, February 8th, from 9:00 am – 12:00 pm. Of course, make sure your quilts are clean and smell good. And that they are in good shape. To ensure a safe return of your quilt(s), you will receive a receipt when you drop off your quilt. You **must** have that receipt to get your quilt back after the show. Your quilt must

have: 1) Label that is covered. Safety Pins or tape. But no straight pins. 2) Each quilt dropped off in its own bag, which is labeled with members name and the name of the quilt. 3) Make sure you have a “sleeve” for the top of your quilt, about 4” wide. If your quilt is 70” or more, make sure that your sleeve has a slit in the middle of the sleeve. 4) If you are not able to drop off your quilt at turn-in-day, please contact Beverly Pierzchala. 5) Quilts will be held in a lock room. 6) **Final**

Inspection – After picking up your quilt, by turning in your Ticket stub which you received on Turn-in-Day, it is up to you to make sure your quilt is the one inside the bag. Carolyn Finlayson is heading up the Quilt Show volunteer shifts. Contact Carolyn if you wish to volunteer to work any part of the two days of the show Carolyn Pic has the signup sheet for the observation of the judging of the quilts. Alana Yuratich is heading up the hospitality part of the show. Signup sheets are available to volunteer to bring food that is available to all workers that work the show on Friday and Saturday. Cher Adams working on the Quilt Show brochure/program. She would like for you to have checked with her to make sure she has entered all quilt entry info correctly. Sarah Hutton is heading up the Hanging Day, which is held the Thursday before the show February 10. There will be an instruction meeting at 9:00 am. Hanging should start around 9:30 am. Aking Osborne is in charge of the Silent Auction area. Aking encouraged everyone to check out the items and baskets available to bid on. Some really nice items. Several of the Beehives will be donating baskets with themed items or the auction.

Also remember there are raffle tickets available for items in this section also. Carolyn Pic is in charge of Raffle Tickets. She has more available for those that wish to pre-sell tickets. 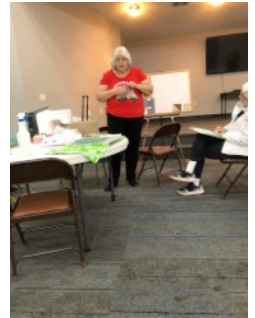
